

WORLD SOCIAL WORK DAY 2008 - CHINA

A Symposium co-sponsored by the China Association of Social Workers and the China Association for Social Work Education was held at Peking University to mark the Second World Social Work Day.

The Symposium was addressed by Vice-Minister of Civil Affairs and several of the best-known sociologists and social work leaders in China. Their statements, while centering around the theme "Making a World of Difference", stressed the importance of social work in building a harmonious society.

A letter of proposal was approved by the Symposium and read out to the public by the Secretary-General of the China Association of Social Workers, the content of which will be communicated later.
