

## Steps for making a Climate Justice Contribution:

- 1) Enter your travel details using the prompts below and press the button to "Calculate". Or, you do not need to go through the calculator if you simply want to name your own amount for a donation. You may simply put any number into the box under "Name your own contribution".
- After you have calculated your suggested contribution amount, and adjusted the amount as you see necessary, then please select the Climate Justice Projects to which you would like your contribution to be applied.
- 3) Proceed with your contribution by clicking the button "Add to Cart", then you will be moved to the next screen to check out and provide your method of payment.

## How will you be traveling?

Did you know that trains (which carry many people to share the carbon offset) have the lowest ecological footprint? Typically, trains have  $\frac{1}{2}$  the ecological footprint of flying the same distance, and  $\frac{1}{4}$  the footprint of driving a car that distance. Please consider all options when you are making your travel plans, including mode of transportation, and sharing transportation with others traveling to the same destination.

## How will my contribution be used?

For example, contributions to the active CJP in the Latin America & the Caribbean Climate Justice Project, «The Renewable Energy and Empowerment of Quechua Women» in Buena Vista, Bolivia, will be used for expenses such as:

\$20 pays for one woman (food and lodging included) to participate in 1 day of the 4-day workshop where she will learn to build a solar oven or bicycle blender.

\$20 pays for one woman's round-trip transportation to participate in the workshop.

\$60 pays for the transportation for the 2 workshop facilitators.

\$80 pays for one woman (food and lodging included) to participate in the full 4-day workshop to build a solar oven or bicycle blender.

\$100 pays for the materials for one solar oven or one bicycle blender.
