What have been your main achievements in this role in the last year?

The main goals are still to refresh, dynamize, and solidify the contact and cooperation with the Agency, aiming to build reliability and reaffirm the value of IFSW Europe – and the profession we represent – as a key partner.

Although we managed to increase the frequency of our contacts, they are currently again one-directional and not fluid/dynamic. Yet the relationship and work philosophy still seem stable and strong in the instances in which they could be evaluated.

In a nutshell, there are still some communication issues (formal/administrative), most of which have been addressed in the past but seem to persist. Although it seemed to improve, it is still necessary to keep working on some formal issues such as updating contact data, clarifying interlocutors, ...

An IFSW Europe – FRA joint review of the cooperation might help clarify its optimal operation and address current issues.
