## Motion for IFSW (Europe) Delegates Meeting 2024 from Irish Association of Social Workers (IASW) in relation to the European Union (EU) Pact on Migration and Asylum

The IFSW calls on the European Commission and all EU member states to promote a human rights-led, equitable and person-centred approach when implementing the Pact on Migration and Asylum. All member state asylum systems should be designed to ensure the dignity and human rights of all persons applying for asylum.

The IFSW demands that the building blocks for the Pact common implementation plan begin with protecting the right to asylum and stepping up efforts in the area of resettlement, inclusion and integration.

The IFSW calls on the Commission to require EU member states to explicitly describe measures to instil anti-racist and person-centred practices within asylum and reception systems in national implementation plans.
