Call for Papers

Social Work is a scientific knowledge and skill-based profession which provides counseling services in different setting to the disadvantaged group of people in particular throughout the world. It extends services for the underprivileged group of people irrespective of age, sex, religion, economic status, race and education as well towards sustainable rehabilitation. In Asia, the practices of social work are still not remarkably mentionable in the field of social services because of its less expansion and orientation among the mass people. Social Work can contribute in peace building and transformation of the human society of Bangladesh and bring positive social changes and make a livable community.

“Social work is a practice-based profession and an academic discipline that promotes social change and development, social cohesion, and the empowerment and liberation of people. Principles of social justice, human rights, collective responsibility and respect for diversities are central to social work. Underpinned by theories of social work, social sciences, humanities and indigenous knowledge, social work engages people and structures to address life challenges and enhance wellbeing”.
