INCREASING RESPONSIVENESS TO CITIZEN VOICE IN SOCIAL SERVICES ACROSS EUROPE

A Horizon Europe Research and Innovation Action for the call "The future of democracy and civic participation". **Start date: 1 March 2023, 36-month project**

The RESPONSIVE project aims to increase responsiveness to citizen voices in three types of social service:

- Community-based disability and mental health services
- Child protection services
- Services for young people at risk of social exclusion

The project is framed around the concept of 'responsiveness' within social services as a new way of thinking about democracy and co-creation in the context of citizen-government interaction. This concept focuses on *changes* and concrete actions within social services prompted by learning from citizen perspectives and voices. The project has six core objectives, each met by a work package:

- 1. Analyse the **normative**, **legal**, **policy and practice contexts** at local, national and EU level shaping how social services respond to the perspectives of diverse citizens (WP1)
- 2. Assess official channels of citizen input in social services (advisory groups, consultations, complaints, evaluation mechanisms) (WP2)
- 3. Analyse public actions by citizens to change social services (campaigns, social media, social enterprise, artistic production, protests) (WP3)
- 4. Identify the factors shaping **changes by social services** in response to the input of diverse citizens who use social services (WP4)
- 5. **Co-design and test tailored innovations** for citizens, civil society groups, social services and policymakers to expand the utilisation of different sources of citizen knowledge by social services at different levels (WP5)
- 6. Promote the uptake of innovations through dissemination of project results (WP6)
