### About the Forum

## **Accommodation**

The accommodations will be provided at

1. The Learning and Training Center on Older Persons, comprise 72 air-conditioned rooms with 2 beds, TV, refrigerator and water heater.
2. Institute of Community Development, located about 1 km. from The Learning and Training Center on Older Persons.
3. The COP Seminar & Resort, locate about 2 km. from The Learning and Training Center on Older Persons.

Accommodation places number #1 and #2 are included in the registration fee. In case of single occupancy, there is an additional charge of 10 USD per night. Accommodation number #3 requires an additional charge on top of the registration fee. It depends on the type of room, minimum price is about 10 USD per room per night.

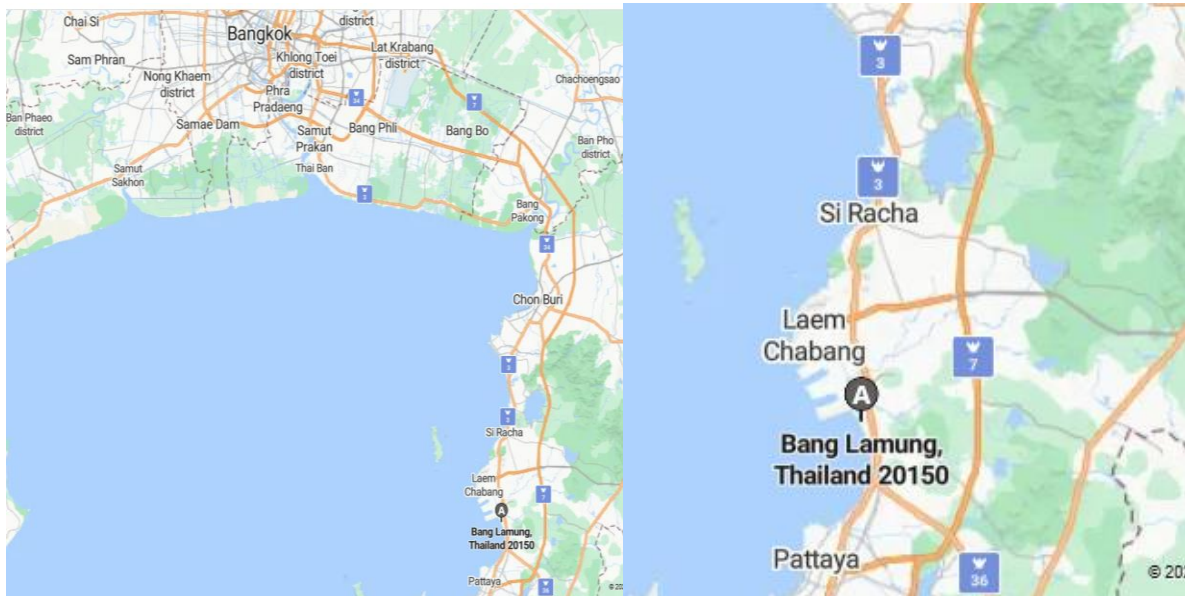
Abstract (about 150-250 words) submission is accepted from January 15, 2024 to February 15, 2024.
